-  Please do not book journeys directly with our drivers. Please ring 0300 30 30 125 to book all journeys.
-  Tell us as soon as you receive your appointment date and time to give us time to find a driver.
-  We must receive at least 2 working days notice of your appointment.
-  When we have found a driver for your journey, we will ring you to confirm the details. Your journey is not confirmed until you receive this call.
-  We ask passengers to be considerate and not ask our drivers to make detours.
-  We are sorry, but we cannot accommodate wheelchairs.
-  We politely request that you are ready to be collected at the agreed pickup time.
-  If your health is such that you think you might need medical support to make your journey, please consider using hospital transport instead.
-  As this is a service provided by volunteers, we cannot guarantee that we can find a driver for every journey.
-  Passengers must meet the cost of any car parking (if applicable) or congestion charge.
-  We will not tolerate rudeness or verbal/physical abuse of our staff and volunteers.
-  If terms and conditions are breached, we reserve the right to terminate your membership.
